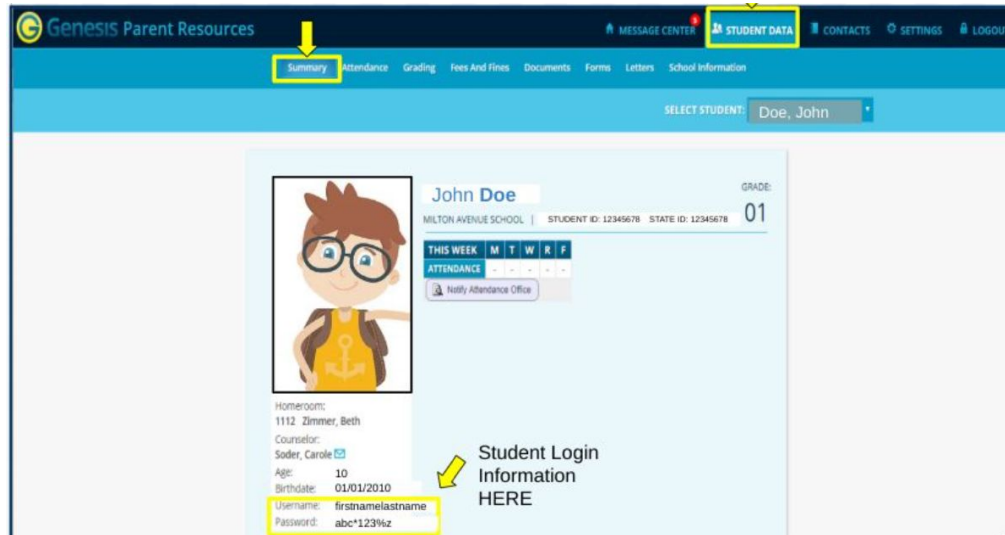


Google Classroom - Learning Management System (Grades K-8)

In grades K-8 at the School District of the Chathams, we utilize the G-Suite for Education's Google Classroom as our learning management system (LMS). Google Classroom enables our teachers to easily create, distribute, and collect digital assignments in one location. Your son/daughter will learn how to access and use Google Classroom with the support of his/her teacher(s). In school, students in grades K-1 typically log in to their Chromebook to access Google Classroom using a QR Code (*also called a Clever badge*). K-1 students can still log in to the Chromebook using their district provided username and password if they have misplaced their Clever badge. Students in grades 2-8 use their district provided username and password to log into the Chromebooks and Google Classroom. If your son/daughter does not remember his/her username and/or password, this information can be found in the [Parent Portal](#). Once you log in, the information can be found within the "Summary" tab.



To log into Google Classroom, your son/daughter can navigate to <https://googleapps.chatham-nj.org/> and click on the Google Classroom icon.



It will bring you to the login page where s/he will enter his/her school provided username and password.
